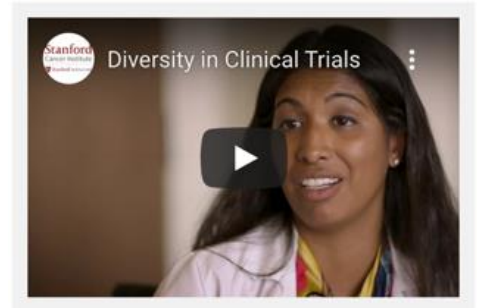

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**Every Woman Counts Program** | Every Woman Counts (EWC) provides free breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services to California's underserved populations.

Do you qualify for free services? You may if you:

- are 21 years old or older
- have low income (EWC Income Criteria)
- have no or limited insurance
- are not getting these services through Medi-Cal or another government-sponsored program
- live in California

We speak English, Spanish, Arabic, Armenian, Cambodian/Khmer, Cantonese, Farsi, Hindi, Hmong, Japanese, Korean, Laotian, Mandarin, Punjabi, Russian, Tagalog, Thai and Vietnamese. If you don't qualify, the EWC representative for your area may know of other low-cost screening programs that might be available to you.
