The Feed component provides an easy way to embed a dynamic feed of content from another website or blog (e.g. embedding blog entries from a WordPress site). Any RSS feed is compatible so if you find a feed source that helps your audience then give this a try.

- Custom heading text
- Multiple layouts
- Entry limiters and filters
- Date toggles
