

Outcome

26 participants, 3 major+2 minor themes

Lessons/themes per SNFs

- 1. Develop workforce pipelines CNA/LVN/RN training, retention
- 2. Clarify guidance (SF, state,fed)
- 3. Improve MC/MC reimbursement
- 4. MH resources for SNF residents
- 5. Childcare/school for SNF staff

Recommendations

- -Connect SNFs & vocational schools, educational incentives retain and develop staff;
- -Make guidance relevant/usable
- -Share best practices across long-term care facilities & DPH



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
